RIMOM 2013 EVENT SUMMARY

On the weekend of June 1-2, 2013 the Community College of Rhode Island's Dental Hygiene clinic at the Lincoln campus was transformed into a fully operational large-scale free dental clinic equipped with more than 25 dental chairs, digital radiography, a sterilization center, and electronic dental records.

The clinic was staffed with over 360 dental & medical volunteers and over 225 community volunteers who graciously gave their time, tal-



ent and clinical expertise to provide dental services to over 900 deserving patients. These services were available to the uninsured, the underinsured and anyone who otherwise has difficulty getting to a dentist.

At the clinic, patients underwent a health and dental evaluation, and received treatment on a first-come, first-served basis, based on their oral health needs.

There was no charge to patients who receive treatment.
