RIMOM EVENT SUMMARY 2016



In 2016 as in years past, the RIMOM patient line forms early each morning with the hope to receive much needed free dental services.



The need has not diminished...

On the weekend of June 4th & June 5th 2016 the Rhode Island Oral Health Foundation convened its 5th annual Mission of Mercy (RIMOM) Free Dental Clinic at the Community College of Rhode Island Lincoln campus. The event is in response to the dire need in Rhode Island for access to affordable dental care.

More than 400 dental and medical professionals came together this year to provide free of charge these much needed dental services. Joining in their efforts were over 250 community volunteers and 11 community agencies. Volunteers from these agencies provided patients a variety of health services and information while they waited for dental treatment.

By 6:00 AM on Saturday, the line of people waiting outside for free dental services wrapped around the building. Some pitched tents the day before, while others started lining up in the middle of the night for the chance to get much needed dental care thus providing clear evidence that the need has not diminished.

For the past five years as we walked through the line, we are reminded that many people who come to RIMOM are in a constant struggle regarding their dental health. As we talk to our patients, we hear heartbreaking stories told with humility as to what brought them to this much needed event. For most, it comes down to having to make a decision to pay for their oral health care or to pay their rent and purchase food. A choice that people should not have to make.

Patients come to us with the hope of being free of pain and infection by having a tooth extracted or restored. With hopes of receiving new front teeth so they can once again smile and feel good about themselves or to receive a cleaning in a effort to maintain good oral health.

After waiting hours for their treatment, it is truly astounding to witness the amount of gratitude shown by our patients for the services we provide. "Thank you", "God Bless you", "You are angels" are words spoken thousands of times throughout the day. Tears of relief and happiness stream down the faces of both patients and volunteers and by the close of the clinic on Sunday, we come to the same conclusion each year, we will continue to hold this event until there is no longer a need.


